# BATIK WORKSHOPS at Rainbow View



BATIK IS A FUN AND COLOURFUL WAY OF CREATING AN IMAGE ON CLOTH USING HOT WAX AND DYES.

Manu is a self-taught artist who began teaching in 1980. He worked in London for many years as a community artist taking batik painting into schools, community centres, libraries, museums, youth clubs, summer schools, cultural festivals and adult education institutes.

The direct dyeing/painting method of batik that Manu practises is a practical, versatile and fun way of creating vibrantly colourful patterns and images on cloth using the traditional wax resist method of Batik.

This course offers plenty of practical experience and is suitable for beginners, those with some experience and more advanced techniques for those participants wishing to develop existing skill levels.

Together Manu and his partner Edi invite you to stay in their welcoming and colourful home set in a productive organic permaculture garden with far-reaching rural views.

Accommodation is comfortable and simple, we provide your bed linen - you bring towels. There are hot showers (solar hot water and wood pellet boiler) and cosy woodburners and an abundance of delicious home made food, hand made bread from our own micro bakery and organic produce from our vegetable garden.

Residential courses are limited to 6 residential participants allowing plenty of time for individual attention. The courses takes place over 2 days, either midweek from Tuesday mid-afternoon until Thursday mid-afternoon or at weekends from Friday mid-afternoon to Sunday mid-afternoon, with practical half-day sessions on the first and last day and a full day (10 - 5) in between.

Cost: £200 (includes tuition, materials, accommodation, breakfast, light lunch & supper with wine) this price is for a shared room (maximum 2 per room), £240 for a private room.

Cost for non residential : £120 (includes vegetarian light lunch on both days as well as all materials)
